Recap – Inspection Verification



- ▣ Passing inspection required for registration
- ▣ Automatic check to verify inspection
- ▣ Registration sticker is proof of registration *and* inspection
- ▣ State's portion of inspection fee, if any is due, collected at registration

- ❑ Inspection fee is a separate line item
- ❑ Updated text in blue box at top of notice (not shown)
- ❑ Updated text on back of notice

What Changes in Phase II?



Inspection & Registration – Together At Last!

- ❑ Phase II begins March 1, 2016 for registration renewal or issuance
- ❑ Statutory timeframes for registration renewal or issuance will be enforced
 - ❑ TxDMV systems will automatically determine if timeframe requirement met
- ❑ Vehicle records that display “Verify Inspection” remark
 - ❑ Driver must be able to provide current VIR when requested by law enforcement
 - ❑ Citation can be issued by law enforcement if no current VIR provided

Phase II Timeframe: Renewal



Inspection & Registration – Together At Last!

- ❑ Inspection no earlier than 90 days before registration expiration
 - ❑ Example: Registration expires March 2016
Inspection 90 day timeframe: January 2nd through March 31st
Vehicle passed inspection January 31, 2016
- ✓ Registration can be renewed

Phase II Timeframe: Registration Issuance – Private party (non-dealer)



- ❑ Vehicle new to the state:
 - ❑ Inspection must have at least one month remaining after the title application date to issue title and registration
 - ❑ Example: Customer applies for title and registration March 20, 2016
Inspection must have at least one full month remaining
Vehicle passed inspection March 20, 2016
- ✓ Title application can be processed and registration can be issued

Phase II Timeframe: Registration Issuance – Dealer Used Vehicle Sales (1YR INSPECTION)



- ❑ Inspect within 180 days of sale date for used vehicle
 - ❑ Example: Dealer sells used vehicle August 1, 2016
(Inspection 180 day timeframe: February 4, 2016 through August 1, 2016)
Vehicle passed inspection May 1, 2016
- ✓ Title application can be processed and registration can be issued (no new inspection needed)

Phase II Timeframe: Registration Issuance – Dealer Used Vehicle Sales (2YR INSPECTION)



- ❑ Date of sale less than 180 days from beginning of year two of inspection
 - ❑ Example: Dealer sells used vehicle June 1, 2016
 - Vehicle was inspected on January 1, 2015
 - Year Two of Inspection begins January 1, 2016
 - (Inspection 180 day timeframe: January 1st through June 29th)
 - ✓ Title application can be processed and registration can be issued (no new inspection required)

Phase II Timeframe: Registration Issuance – Dealer New Vehicle Sales



- ❑ Remember: At least one month of inspection remaining on date of sale for new vehicle

- ❑ Inspection cannot expire same month as date of sale




