# Recap – Inspection Verification



Inspection & Registration – Together At Last!

- ▣ Passing inspection required for registration
- ▣ Automatic check to verify inspection at time of registration
- ▣ Registration sticker is proof of registration *and* inspection
- ▣ State's portion of inspection fee collected at registration, if applicable

# What Changes in Phase II?



Inspection & Registration – Together At Last!

- ❑ Phase II begins March 1, 2016 for registration issuance or renewal
  
- ❑ Statutory timeframes for registration will be enforced by TxDMV systems
  - ❑ webDEALER provides assistance that supporting documentation and inspection verification can be easily processed at the county

## Phase II timeframe: Renewal



Inspection & Registration – Together At Last!

- ❑ Inspection no earlier than 90 days before registration expiration
  - ❑ Example: Registration expires March 2016  
Inspection 90 day timeframe: January 2<sup>nd</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>  
Vehicle passed inspection January 31, 2016
- ✓ Registration can be renewed

# Timeframe for Registration Issuance – Dealer Used Vehicle Sales (1YR INSPECTION)



- ❑ Inspect within 180 days preceding the sale date for used vehicle
  - ❑ Example: Dealer sells used vehicle August 1, 2016  
(Inspection 180 day timeframe: February 3, 2016 through August 1, 2016)  
Vehicle passed inspection May 1, 2016
- ✓ Title application can be processed and registration can be issued (no new inspection needed)

# Timeframe for Registration Issuance – Dealer Used Vehicle Sales (2YR INSPECTION)



- ❑ Date of sale within 180 days from beginning of year two of inspection
  - ❑ Example: Dealer sells used vehicle June 1, 2016
    - Vehicle was inspected on January 1, 2015
    - Year Two of Inspection begins January 1, 2016
    - (Inspection 180 day timeframe: January 1<sup>st</sup> through June 29<sup>th</sup> 2016)
- ✓ Title application can be processed and registration can be issued (no new inspection required)

# Timeframe for Registration Issuance

## - Dealer New Vehicle Sales



- ❑ To register and title, at least one month of inspection remaining on date of sale for a new vehicle (2YR or 1YR inspection)

- ❑ Example: Dealer sells new vehicle August 1, 2016  
(Inspection cannot expire same month as the date of sale)

Vehicle passed inspection May 1, 2016

- ✓ Title application can be processed and registration can be issued

# Impact to TxDMV systems



TxDMV title and registration renewal systems impacted by single sticker:

- ▣ RTS used by counties and subcontractors
- ▣ IVTRS for online renewal at [texas.gov](http://texas.gov)
- ▣ webDEALER for dealer title transactions

These systems will automatically determine if the inspection meets the required timeframe.

# TxDMV system: webDEALER



Inspection & Registration – Together At Last!

- ▣ Process title applications same as today
- ▣ Automatic check of inspection database to confirm current and passing vehicle inspection
- ▣ If no inspection record is found:
  - Enter the date of inspection and inspection type
  - Upload a copy of the VIR
- ▣ webDEALER will calculate any inspection fee due to the county



Verify that the most recent vehicle inspection was conducted on or between **September 3, 2015** and **March 1, 2016**. If the passing vehicle inspection does not fall within this 180-day window, the vehicle must be re-inspected prior to sale.
